IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW

The Conference atmosphere is "Christian Casual", and we encourage you to be prepared for a warm day or cool morning and evening. You should bring personal items (**including towel for swimming and toiletries**), Bible, and anything you would need to make your stay comfortable. Harvey Cedars is an alcohol and smoking/tobacco free facility and these items are prohibited on grounds. The bay and beach are in walking distance.

REMEMBER... This weekend is for you to recharge your spiritual batteries. There are no care facilities for young ones, and minors must be accompanied by an adult at all times when they are on the grounds, which includes ABGIRLS. Whether attending events or not, anyone on grounds counts as an adult for meals and accommodations, and must pay accordingly.

DIRECTIONS- Take the Garden State Parkway (North or South) to exit 63. Follow Route 72 East to dead-end on Long Beach Island. Turn left onto Long Beach Island Boulevard and travel North approximately 4 miles to the second traffic light in Harvey Cedars. Turn left at light (Camden Ave.), cross small wooden bridge and turn left again on Cedars Ave. We are on the right-hand side in the Bayview Lodge. ABW signs will be posted.

ACCOMMODATION CHOICES- **Bayview Lodge** has two floors and each room has 2 queen size beds and full bath. The **Bayview Addition** is available for two night stays only, and includes two twin beds and one queen size bed, minimum occupancy 3 persons. Both the Lodge and Addition have access to an elevator. A limited number of fully handicapped accessible rooms are available on a first come, first served basis to those who need handicapped accessible bathrooms. No single occupancy permitted. Those who wish to receive confirmation should provide an email address in the space provided.

ABGIRLS- We welcome 7th to 12th grade girls to come on Saturday and enjoy their own program. This year we are offering a special discount to those who stay with the group as chaperones (and do not attend ABW events). See the registration form for details. Girls will be required to submit a parent/guardian consent form which can be obtained by contacting Joan Moyer. Our leader will be Lynette Smith.

PURSE AUCTION & FORGOTTEN TREASURES We encourage you to bring an item for our purse auction and/or attic treasures. Purses should be new and contain new items as well as an auction value and description. The forgotten treasure items can be gently used but limited to one donation per person.

BOOK SWAP – Have some inspirational materials just taking up space? Bring and leave them at the book swap so someone can take them home and continue to use them. Gently used non-fiction and fiction books, dvd's, etc are welcome. **Please take any of your remaining items back home with you.**

BOOK TALK- Thursday and Friday evenings participants can discuss "Homeless at Harvard" by John Christopher Frame and "Kisses from Katie" by Katie Davis. Both powerful and riveting true stories of how God uses ordinary people to do extraordinary things. Participants should bring their own books. A limited number of books will be available at Spring Rally.

STATE PROJECT Gloves for Warmth and Work- In keeping with our theme of "Feel/ Siente" we will be collecting gloves for women, children, and men for warmth and for work. They will be distributed to agencies in north & south Jersey to be given to the homeless in their areas. Please bring new gloves you have purchased. Monetary contribution will also accepted to purchase more gloves. This will be an ongoing project until Conference 2019.

CONFERENCE PROJECT- Blessing Bags: Both adult and kid's kits will be collected. These are filled with much needed personal care items and will be presented to WomenSpace. There will be bags available at Spring Rally and more to be filled with items brought to at conference. Full size Products: Adult Kits include: body wash, wash cloth, towel, lotion, shampoo, conditioner, toothpaste & toothbrush. Kid Kits include: children's bath/body wash, wash cloth, towel, child shampoo, child lotion, toothpaste & toothbrush.
